Summary



This award recognizes a graduating Coronado High School student who has demonstrated exemplary humanitarian service, with an emphasis on personal volunteer efforts and active involvement in helping others in the community.

The scholarship is a \$2,500 award credited to the selected student's community college or technical school of choice. Two scholarships will be given. Half the award will be available for each of two terms.

Eligible Students

Seniors in good standing at Coronado High School who will graduate no later than the end of the Spring Term. While grade point average is not a selection criterion, only students who are committed to continuing their education beyond high school (college or vocational/technical school) will be considered.

Selection Process

Complete the Application Cover Sheet along with the required additional documentation and submit to the Coronado High School Guidance Counseling Office.

Those documents include:

- Application Cover Sheet
- Applicant's essay detailing an understanding and application of the concept of "Service Above Self."
- Personal Resumé
- Two letters of support from individuals who are personally knowledgeable of the applicant's volunteer activities.

The Scholarship Committee at Coronado High School will complete an initial screening of applicants. The Committee will verify each applicant's eligibility and nominate at least two and no more than five qualified students to be interviewed by the Coronado Foundation for the Future Scholarship Committee.

The Coronado Foundation for the Future Scholarship Committee is comprised of members of the Foundation's Board of Directors and includes former members of the Papago Rotary Club of Scottsdale. The Committee will schedule an interview with each of the finalists. The committee shall consider the merits of each applicant and select an award winner. The decisions of the Committee are final.

Completed Scholarship applications, including all supporting materials (resume', reference letters, etc.) must be submitted the date identified by the Guidance Counseling Office. Check with your Counselor for more information.

Letters of Recommendation from two individuals who are knowledgeable about your volunteer service activities.
